### **“Riders Ready...”**

#### **The Gate Drop - Enter the Archive**

Navigate to LititzBMX.com. You should land on the Welcome page - the starting gate of the archive.

#### **First Straight - Explore the Archive Inventory**

Locate the main inventory.

Review how the archive is organized. What patterns do you notice in how items are cataloged?

#### **First Berm - Navigate Through the Artifacts**

Select an artifact page and explore it.

What drew your attention to this artifact?

What media helped you understand the artifact?

What connections stand out to you?

#### **Second Straight - Follow a Rider's Story**

Find a rider profile and learn about their background.

What makes their story significant to BMX history?

#### **Second Berm - Make a Connection**

Identify another artifact or page connected to that rider.

How are the two linked?

#### **Third Straight - Explore a Collection**

Navigate to a collection page.

What theme or story connects the items within it?

#### **Third Berm - Discover the Bigger Picture**

Find a campaign, learning resource, or story page.

What message or idea is being shared?
